Day 01- 02 (11 Sept 2012 - 12 Sept 2012)

Assemble at Cochin / Trivandrum International Airport at 2300 Hours.

The flight details are as follows: -

On arrival at Amman Airport, we will proceed towards Sheikh Hussein Bridge after visa processing, which takes approx three hours. We can use the washroom facilities at the airport to refresh. Later on we shall proceed for lunch or we will be served with sandwich & soft drink. **[DEPENDING UPON THE WAITING TIME AT THE AIRPORT]**. Later we proceed from the Amman Airport to Israel Border (Sheik Hussian Bridge). **[The time taken to cover the Jordan & Israel Immigration will take about 3 Hours]**.

NB : Please carry some dry snacks with you while travelling from Amman Airport to Israel.

We board our luxury coach to Tiberias hotel. **(Israel Border to Tiberias hotel 1½ Hours)**. On arrival in Tiberias City, check-in to the hotel. The tour leader will take about 30 minutes to deliver the room keys as allotted. Baggage will be transferred to each room by the bell boys. **(in case of urgency you can carry your baggage along with you to avoid time delay)**.

Dinner time will be announced by the tour leader. Overnight stay in Hotel.

Day 03 (13 Sept 2012)

Wake up call at 0500 Hours. Breakfast served from 0600 Hours. Board your coach by 0700 Hours for full day sight seeing

- ❖ **Mount Tabore:** Mount Tabor is a hill, rising 500m above the Jezreel Valley in the region of Galilee. Christians have identified a rock atop Mt. Tabor as the place of the Transfiguration of Christ since the 4th century AD.

Ref:From the Bible: ([Judges 4:6-7] [Psalm 89:12] [Jeremiah 46:18] [Mt 17:1-9])

- ❖ **Capernaum "The Town of Jesus" :** Capernaum is an ancient fishing village on the north shore of the Sea of Galilee in Israel. It is home to a celebrated Byzantine-era synagogue as well as the house where Jesus healed a paralytic and St. Peter's mother-in-law.

- ❖ **Tagha:** The Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes (also known as the Church of the Multiplication) is a church in Tabgha (ancient Heptapegon) on the northwest shore of the Sea of Galilee.

Ref:From the Bible: (Mark 6:30-44, Mark 6:40-44)

- ❖ **St.Peter's Primacy** : The Church of the Primacy of Peter is a modest Franciscan chapel that incorporates part of a 4th-century church. It is located at Tabgha on the northwest shore of the Sea of Galilee and commemorates Jesus' reinstatement of Peter after a fish breakfast on the shore.

Ref:From the Bible: (John 21, John 21:9, John 21:15-19, John 21:9, Luke 22:30)

- ❖ **Galilee Boat Ride :**

The Galilee Boat is made of 12 different types of wood and measures 25.5 ft. (8.2 m) long, 7.5 ft. (2.3 m) wide, and 4.1 ft (1.25 m) high

- ❖ **St. Peter's Fish Lunch**

Three types of fish were primarily sought by fishermen in antiquity in these waters. Sardines likely were the "two small fish" that the boy brought to the feeding of the 5000. The third type is called popularly known today as "St. Peter's Fish." This fish has a long dorsal fin.

- ❖ **Annunciation Church.**

The Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth is a modern Catholic church built over the remains of Byzantine and Crusader churches. It incorporates the cave in which Virgin Mary received the news from Gabriel that she would give birth to Jesus.

- ❖ **Cana of Galilee +TIME FOR SHOPPING CANA WEDDING WINE.**

Cana is a Galilean town five miles northeast of Nazareth. The site of Jesus' first miracle or turning water into wine at a wedding, KafraKanna.

Ref:From the Bible: (John 2:1-11)

- ❖ **The Baptismal Site – Yardenit** : The baptismal site on the Jordan River. If one is being baptized, you are required to wear a baptismal robe. They will charge you \$10 towards the cost of renting a baptismal robe which includes a towel, entrance to the change facility and a baptismal certificate.

Ref:From the Bible:

(2 Kings 2:6-12, John 1:25-28, John 10:40-42, Luke 3:1, 5-6, Mark 1:4-5, 9-12, Matthew 3:13-17, Luke 3:21-23).

In the evening we proceed to the hotel for dinner & overnight stay at hotel.

Day 04 (14 Sept 2012)

Wake up call at 0500 Hours. Breakfast served from 0630 Hours. Check out from the hotel and board your coach at 0730 Hours

- ❖ **Mt. Beatitudes:** Located on a small hill overlooking the Sea of Galilee near Tabgha, the Mount of Beatitudes is the traditional site of Jesus' delivery of the Sermon on the Mount, probably the most famous sermon of all time.

Ref: From the Bible: (Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth." (Mt 5:1-5))

- ❖ **Haifa :** Like most of Israel, Haifa has been populated since ancient times. Elijah is the city's most famous early inhabitant; He meditated here in a cave before defeating the priests of Baal.
- ❖ **Caesarea :** Also known as Caesarea Palaestina and Caesarea Maritima, is an ancient city, now archaeological park, located on the Mediterranean Sea 33 miles north of Joppa and 60 miles northwest of Jerusalem.

We will have panoramic view in the bus only. We will not be entering the Caesarea Site

- ❖ **Mt. Carmel :** Here the southern side of Mt. Carmel near the coast can be seen. Mt. Carmel was most significant in ancient times as a barrier to traffic along the coastal plain.

- ❖ **LUNCH AT RESTAURANT**

- ❖ **Jerusalem**

The most famous Islamic site in Jerusalem is the Dome of the Rock. Jews believed, and still believe, the rock to be the very place where Abraham prepared to sacrifice Isaac.

- ❖ **Garden Tomb :**

The Garden Tomb is an alternative to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher as the actual site of Jesus' burial in Jerusalem. It was discovered in 1867 and is especially popular with Protestants as a place of devotion.

Ref: From The Bible:

Hebrews 13:12 , Matt 27:60 , John 19:41,

The tomb is marked by multilingual signs and a wooden door bearing the English words, **"He is not here - for he is risen."**

Later we proceed to our hotel in Jerusalem / Bethlehem. Check in at Hotel. The tour leader will take about 30 minutes to deliver the room keys as allotted. Baggage will be transferred to each room by the bell boys.**(in case of urgency you can carry your baggage along with you to avoid time delay).**

After getting fresh we will proceed to 7 Arches Hotel at Mount of Olives for meeting starting from 1830 Hours to 2130 Hours.

We have our curtain raiser of: **Heavenly Feast International Conference & Leadership Summit” on Mount of Olives, 7 Arches Hotel, Jerusalem.**

After the conference we have our dinner & overnight stay at our designated hotels.

Day 05 (15 Sept 2012)

Wake up call at 0500 Hours. Breakfast served from 0630 Hours. We board the bus at 0700 Hours.

❖ **Bethlehem**

The Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem is a major Christian holy site, as it marks the traditional place of Christ's birth. It is also one of the oldest surviving Christian churches.

Ref: From the Bible : (Luke 2:7)

- ❖ **Shepherd fields:** The roads descending to the east of Bethlehem lead through mostly Christian village of Beitsahour, which includes the Shepherds' Fields: the fields identified since ancient times with the shepherds who saw the Star of Nativity.

❖ **Holocaust / YAD VASHEM**

The Holocaust was the murder by Nazi Germany of six million Jews. While the Nazi persecution of the Jews began in 1933, the mass murder was committed during World War II. It took the Germans and their accomplices four and a half years to murder six million Jews. They were at their most efficient from April to November 1942 – 250 days in which they murdered some two and a half million Jews.

❖ **LUNCH AT RESTAURANT**

❖ **Pool of Bethsaida,**

The Church of St. Anne is a beautiful 12th-century Crusader church, erected over the traditional site of the birthplace of Anne (Hannah), the mother of Mary. It is an excellent example of Romanesque architecture.

Ref: From The Bible :(John 5:1-15)

❖ **Via Dolorosa or The Way of The Cross [fourteen stations]**

The Via Dolorosa, the route that Jesus took between his condemnation by Pontius Pilate and his crucifixion and burial.

❖ **Western Wall**

The Western Wall in Jerusalem is the holiest of Jewish sites, sacred because it is a remnant of the Herodian retaining wall that once enclosed and supported the Second Temple. It has also been called the "Wailing Wall" by European observers because for centuries Jews have gathered here to lament the loss of their temple.

Back to the hotel, freshen yourself and proceed to 7 Arches Hotel at Mount of Olives for our meeting starting at 1830 Hours to 2130 Hours.

Day 06 (16 Sept 2012)

The meeting is expected to be over by 1400 Hours. After lunch at 7 Arches Hotel we proceed for the tour as follows :-

❖ **Upper Room.**

The Last Supper Room is a second-story room in Jerusalem that commemorates the "upper room" in which Jesus shared the Last Supper with the disciples.

Ref: From the Bible : (Mark 14:12-15)

❖ **DAVID'S TOMB**

The Tomb of David is a much-revered site on Mount Zion in Jerusalem that has been variously owned and jealously guarded by Christians, Muslims and Jews throughout its history. Today it is a Jewish holy site.

Ref : From The Bible : (1 Kings 2:10)

❖ **Dormation Abby**

It was built on land given by the Turkish sultan to the German Kaiser Wilhelm II and commemorates the "falling asleep" (*dormitio*) of the Virgin Mary.

Later transfer to the designated hotels. After freshen up we all proceed towards **"RAMAT RACHEL" for the Inauguration of All Nations Convocation, Jerusalem.**

Later proceed to the designated hotels for dinner & overnight stay.

Day 07 (17 Sept 2012)

Wake up call at 0600 Hours. Breakfast served from 0700 Hours. Depart for the tour at 0800 Hours

❖ **Acension Church**

The Chapel of the Ascension in Jerusalem is a Christian and Muslim holy site that is believed to mark the place where Jesus ascended into heaven. The small round church/mosque contains a stone imprinted with the very footprints of Jesus.

Ref: From the Bible : (Luke 24:50-51 , Acts 1:9-11)

❖ **PaterNoster**

Named for the "Our Father" prayer, the Church of the Paternoster stands on the traditional site in Jerusalem where Jesus taught his disciples the Lord's Prayer. Plaques in the cloister bear the Lord's Prayer in 62 different languages.

Ref: From the Bible :(Luke 11:1-4)

❖ **Dominus Flevit :**

Dominus Flevit Church is a small Franciscan church located on the upper western slope of the Mount of Olives in Jerusalem, the place where Jesus wept.

Ref: From the Bible : (John 11:35 , Luke 19:41)

❖ **Gethsemane**

The Church of All Nations, officially named the Basilica of the Agony, is located at the foot of the Mount of Olives in Jerusalem next to the Garden of Gethsemane.

Ref: From the Bible : (Matthew 26:36-39)

❖ **Jericho – Mount Temptation**

Temptation in the Wilderness. After his baptism, Jesus withdrew into the nearby desert to fast and pray for 40 days. The Devil tried three times to tempt Jesus to break his fast or compromise his mission.

Ref: From the Bible : (Matthew 4:1-11)

❖ **Lazarus tomb**

Bethany is a Muslim and Christian Arab village on the southeast slopes of the Mount of Olives, Jerusalem. Bethany was the home of Lazarus, whom Jesus raised from the dead and his sisters Mary and Martha. Jesus often stayed in their home.

Ref: From the Bible : (Mark 14:3 , Mark 11:11 , Luke 24:50, John 11:38-44)

❖ **Dead Sea**

Referred to as the "Salt Sea" in the Bible. This inland body of water is appropriately named because its high mineral content allows nothing to live in its water. Other post-biblical names for the Dead Sea include the "Sea of Sodom," the "Sea of Lot," the "Sea of Asphalt" and the "Stinking Sea."

Return back to the designated hotels. Dinner & overnight stay at Hotel



Day 08 (18 Sept 2012)

Wake up call at 0600 Hours. Breakfast served from 0700 Hours. Check out from the hotel. We board the bus to Israel Border at 0800 Hours. On reaching Tiberias we have our lunch and reach Sheikh Hussein Bridge. Visa and immigration will take about 3 Hours. Later we proceed to Mount Nebo.

❖ **Mount Nebo**

Mount Nebo is the mountain from which Moses saw the Promised Land before his death. Because of its connection to Moses, Mt. Nebo has long been an important place of Christian pilgrimage.

Ref: From the Bible : (Deuteronomy 34:1-6)

Later arrive in Amman and Check-in to the hotel. The tour leader will take approx 30 minutes to deliver the room keys as allotted. Baggage will be transferred to each room by the bell boys.(in case of urgency you can carry your baggage along with you to avoid time delay).

The dinner time will be announced by the tour leader. Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 09 (19 Sept 2012)

Wake up call at 0600 Hours. Breakfast served from 0700 Hours. Check out from the hotel to board respective flight. Details mentioned below :
